After months of distance learning, the students were eager to be in their classroom before the teacher with their chalk, duster and blackboard. They displayed their eagerness to comply with the new safety regulations and norms.

कोलकाता के उपनगर रिसड़ा में स्थित आदित्य बिड़ला वाणी भारती के यशस्वी प्रधानाचार्य श्री गौतम सरकार जी द्वारा सरकार द्वारा दी गई गाइडलाइन के अनुसार 6 अप्रैल को विद्यालय में छात्रों का आगमन प्रारंभ किया गया।

कोरोना के चलते लंबे समय से बंद पड़े स्कूलों में सरकार की गाइडलाइन के मुताबिक 6 अप्रैल 2022 को हमारे विद्यालय आदित्य बिड़ला वाणी भारती में शिक्षण कार्य प्रारंभ हुआ। इस दौरान जहाँ बच्चों में उत्साह नजर आया वहीं, शिक्षकों ने गेट पर खड़े रहकर बच्चों का स्वागत किया। देखते ही देखते विद्या का मंदिर बच्चों से गुलजार हो गया।

कोरोना संबंधी दिशा निर्देशों का भी विद्यालय में पूरी तरह से अनुपालन किया गया। बच्चे मास्क लगाकर विद्यालय पहुँचे थे तो क्लास रूम में उन्हें शारीरिक दूरी का अनुपालन करते हुए बैठाया गया था। बच्चे अपने दोस्तों से मिल कर उत्साहित नजर आ रहे थे। उधर घरों में सुबह से ही बच्चों को स्कूल भेजने की तैयारी शुरू हो गई थी। बच्चों को ड्रेस पहनाया जा रहा था तो उनके लिए टिफिन भी तैयार हो रहा था। हालांकि शासन के निर्देश के बाद दो दिन पहले से ही हमारे विद्यालय ने अपनी तैयारी शुरू कर दी थी तथा क्लासरूम सहित पूरे विद्यालय परिसर में साफ सफाई की गई थी साथ ही प्रत्येक क्लासरूम को सैनिटाइज किया गया था।

हमारे विद्यालय में प्रवेश द्वार पर ही सैनिटाइजर व मास्क की व्यवस्था रखी गई थी, ताकि कोई बच्चा बगैर मास्क के पहुँचता है तो उसको मास्क उपलब्ध कराया जा सके।

आदित्य बिड़ला वाणी भारती अपने छात्रों के साथ और उनकी सुरक्षा के लिए सदैव सचेष्ट रहा है। महामारी के पश्चात छात्र विद्यालय में आए तो विद्यालय में इस बात का पूरा ध्यान रखा गया कि छात्र किसी प्रकार से अस्वस्थ ना हो। उनके लिए स्वच्छ वातावरण, स्वच्छ परिवेश एवं स्वच्छ जल की व्यवस्था की गई जिससे वे इस बीमारी के संक्रमण से बचे रहें। प्रारंभिक दौर में विद्यालय ने सर्वप्रथम कक्षा 10 वीं, 11 वीं एवं 12 वीं के छात्रों को विद्यालय में आमंत्रित किया तथा उनके लिए अलग समय सारणी का निर्धारण किया गया जिससे वे सुचारु रूप से शिक्षा ग्रहित कर सकें। विद्यालय के हर तल पर हर कक्षा को अच्छी तरह से सैनिटाइज किया गया तथा कक्षा के बाहर सैनिटाइजर की बोटलें रखी गई जिससे बच्चे समय-समय पर स्वयं को सैनिटाइज कर सकें। इसके साथ-साथ अध्यापकों को भी यह सख्त आदेश दिया गया कि बिना मास्क और सैनिटाइजर के किसी कक्षा में प्रवेश नहीं करेंगे जिससे उनके द्वारा बच्चे किसी प्रकार से संक्रमित ना हों और ना तो वे बच्चों द्वारा संक्रमित हों। सुरक्षा हमारा प्रथम लक्ष्य था और उसका अनुपालन आदित्य बिड़ला वाणी भारती ने बड़ी सख्ती के साथ किया।

विद्यालय की इस व्यवस्था को देखते हुए विद्यालय के अभिभावकों ने सहर्ष अपने बच्चों को विद्यालय भेजा जिससे विद्यालय में छात्रों की उपस्थिति उत्कृष्ट रही और बच्चे भी लंबे अंतराल के पश्चात विद्यालय आकर सुरक्षित वातावरण में अत्यंत प्रसन्न थे।

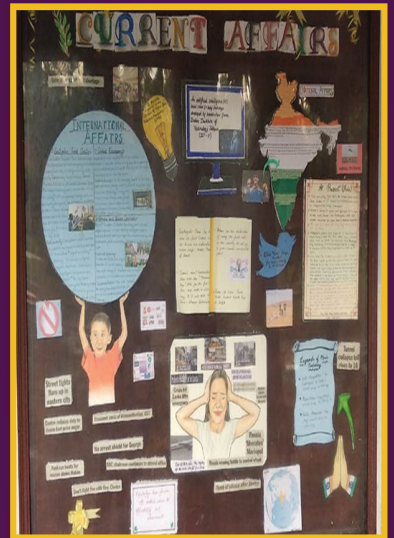

Martand House won the first position. Vivasvan House secured the second position and Bhaskar House occupied the third position.

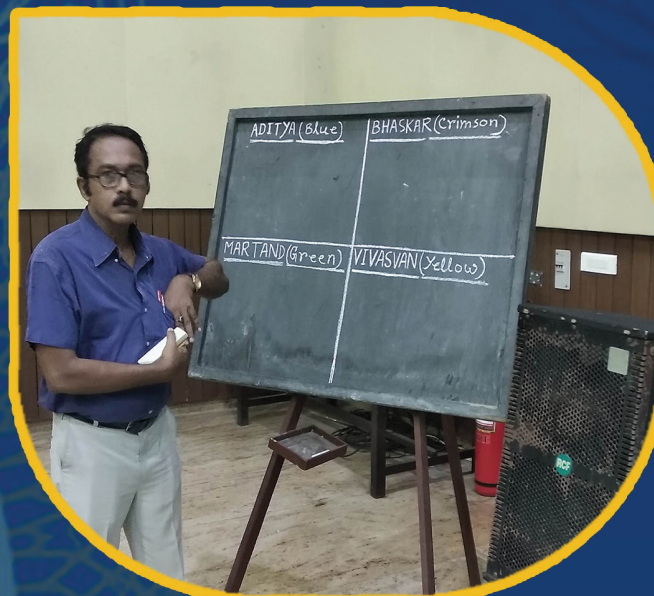

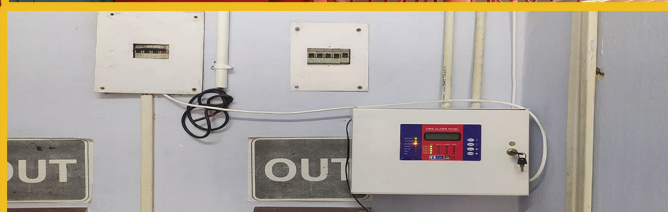

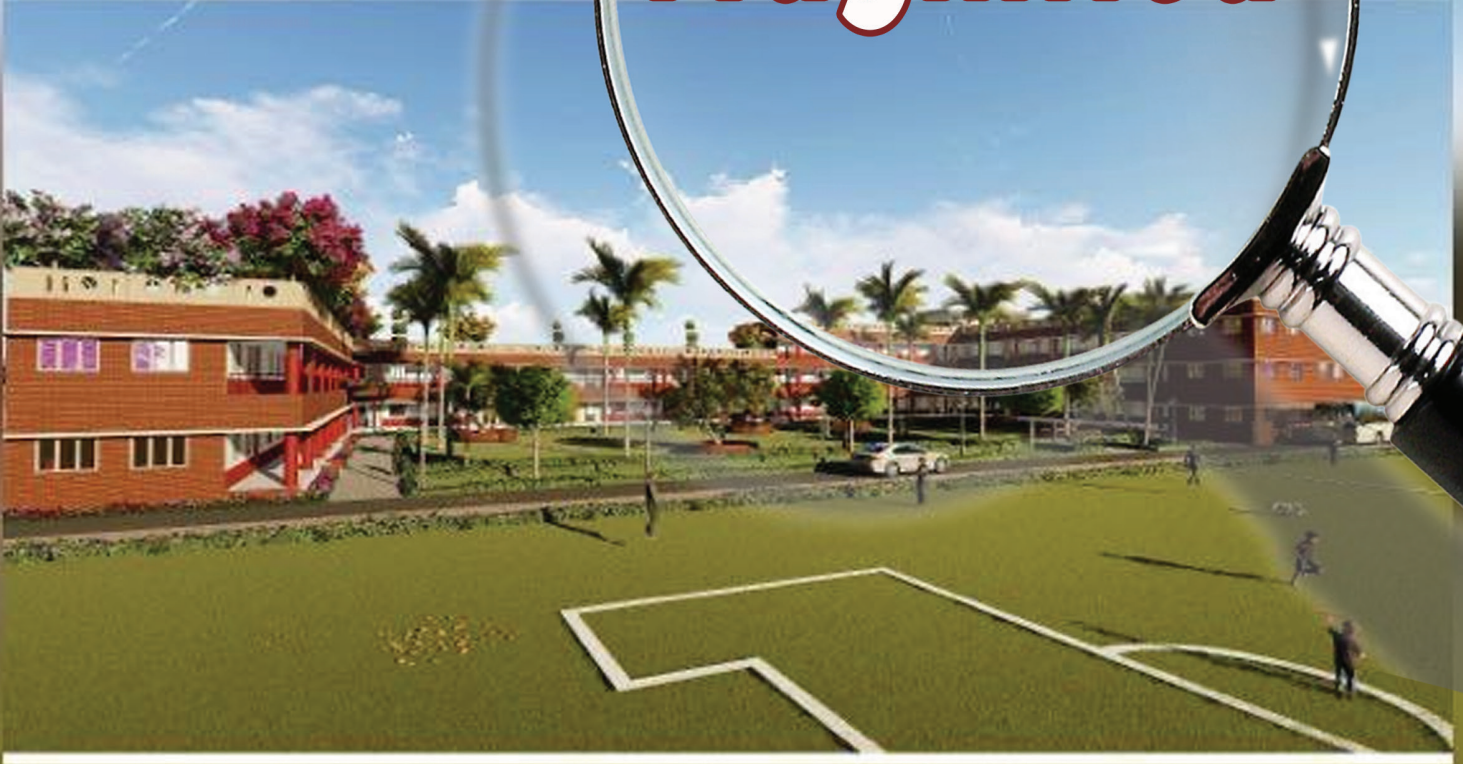
